Kate Rogers' poem, "Black Cloud" won Honourable Mention in the Power Plant Gallery/Toronto International Festival of Authors ekphrastic poetry contest in May 2020.

Other 2020 publication highlights include Poetry Pause (League of Canadian Poets), and Voice & Verse 51: *Emergency*. Kate has poems forthcoming in Trinity 132 (University of Toronto) and *Voice and Verse 52: Masks*.

In 2019 Kate's poems appeared in *Understorey Magazine*; *World Literature Today*; *Algebra of Owls* and *Cha: An Asian Literary Journal*.
